Re: SATs Easter School 2017

As I am sure you will be aware, our Year 6 children will be taking their SATs very soon and as a school we take every opportunity to provide the children with the very best opportunities to achieve at the highest levels before they transfer to their Secondary School settings.

This Easter, I have organised for all Year 6 children to receive **free** tuition sessions, known as Easter School, in preparation for the SATs in May. You will already be aware that the SATs tests that children take in May are used by some Secondary Schools to set up children into ability groups and are, therefore, hugely important to children's success on transfer to Secondary school. These sessions will run from 9:00am to 12:00 noon on Monday 3rd April and run through the week with the last day being Friday 7th April. The sessions will be led by teachers at Lessness as well as some of the Year 6 teachers. During the sessions, children will be given the opportunity to learn about the SATs test, explore skills they will need to use and have personalised support in their areas of development. Children can attend in their own clothes and should bring with them water and a healthy snack for break time. Please drop off at the main school entrance.
