## Forest School Change of Day

Please can we advise you that Forest School sessions will now take place on a Monday instead of Tuesdays. However, for this week only, Miss Bennett will take her own class to Forest School tomorrow, Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> January; this is to ensure each Reception class gets two sessions this half term. They will then go again on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January.

Miss Ransom's class (Cygnet): Monday 16<sup>th</sup> and Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January.

Miss Baker's class (Gosling): Monday 30<sup>th</sup> January and Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February.

I will take the **morning** Nursery children every Monday from Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January. **Nursery children will need to come in wearing a long sleeved t-shirt and sweatshirt or jumper, warm trousers, tights if required and a pair of thick dark coloured socks.**

Nursery and Reception children need waterproof trousers and a jacket or a waterproof suit, spare socks and wellington boots in school at all times. They will be kept in school, except when they require washing. Please ensure these items are named and kept in a bag. ***Children will need a warm hat, scarf and pair of gloves for their Forest School session.***

Last term some children were unable to attend Forest School because their forms had not been returned or because they did not have wellington boots in school. Forest School is an important part of our Early Years curriculum, it is therefore important that your child attends. ***If you have not yet done so, could you please return the consent form and medical questionnaire attached to this letter, without this your child cannot attend the sessions.***
