## Re: Visit to London Aquarium

In Year 2, our topic is "Under the Sea" and we have based our curriculum around this theme. The children have been really excited about this topic and have engaged with both the work at school and their homework. To enhance their learning, we have organised a trip to the London Aquarium on **Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> October 2016**. The children will take public transport to the Aquarium and will have time there to explore the different habitats and creatures that live under the sea. We aim to build on the learning in the classroom with a memorable experience linked so closely to their topic.

The children will be taking the train into London, as we feel this is a great opportunity for them to experience public transport and learn valuable skills at the same time. As we will be walking to and from the station, it is important that the children bring a coat and a bottle of water so that they are fully prepared. Children are expected to be in full school uniform when going on school visits and this includes school shoes. If children do not have full school uniform on the day, then they may not be able to come on the trip. The children will need a packed lunch, which you can provide or children in Key stage 1 are eligible to receive a free packed lunch. Please indicate on the slip if you would like to take advantage of this and complete the attached packed lunch order form by Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> October.

**The cost of the visit is £6 and this will need to be paid via SIMS Agora by Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> October 2016 at the latest.**

The children will need to be in school promptly at **8.40am on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> October** to ensure that we can leave on time to catch our train. The children will return to school for collection as normal at 3.30pm.

If you are able to accompany us on the day, please indicate your interest using the slip below as soon as possible. Please be advised that any adult accompanying us on this visit would be included in our risk assessment and will need to sign a code of conduct form. However, it is the school's policy that parents will not be able to support children in their own child's class.
