Electronic Assessment

All of the schools in the Primary First Trust now use the electronic system for recording children's achievement.

This enables us to analyse how children are doing faster and fill gaps in knowledge and understanding.

All classes have an Assessment display, which the Ambassadors helped the teachers to put up. They are used to help keep children focussed on their targets. Here is Grace with Dove class' Assessment board



New Targets

Targets are really important as they ensure that children know what they need to do to get better.

Writing Targets

We have changed the way that the targets are used in books to make them more child friendly. Children chose a format they like the best and then when they achieve their target, they colour in a symbol. When they have achieved their target three times, they move onto their next one.

Reading Targets

These are group targets that are displayed on the children's table during guided reading. Each day Teachers address these targets when they read with the children

Maths Targets

The children are working towards the targets on their maths passport!

Statutory Assessment

Children in Year 2 and 6 will receive information about how children did in their SATS with their reports.

Children in Year 1 will find about the results of the phonics screen in their report.
