Find out what castles we have in the UK.	2
Make a model of a castle. You can make the whole thing or a particular part, like the drawbridge or a tower.	4
Write a diary in the day in the life of a person who lives in a castle.	3
Visit a local castle. Take pictures of what you see. Write about what you find out.	4
Research the different kind of rooms in a castle. Compare the rooms to the rooms we have in our homes now.	3
Design your own coat of arms. It can be on a shield or flag. You can do it on paper, card or even fabric.	2
List the different jobs that were needed in a castle. Describe one (or some) of them.	2
Make or design a suit of armour. You can make several layers – it could even be on a model that you “dress”.	3
Make a medieval weapon to defend the castle– investigate machines like the trebuchet, bows and arrows or jousting poles.	3
Could you create a castle poem – it might be about what it looks like, maybe down in the dungeons or about attacking a castle.	3
Use 2D shapes to make a picture of a castle. Investigate the shapes that were used for arrow slots or the flags and pennants.	3
Draw a picture of people who may have lived in a castle.	1
