1.	Create a 3D shape to replicate an object in your house (e.g a can of beans or a football).	2
2.	Create your own puppet theatre/stage including finger puppets. (You could include curtains, pretend lights etc.)	3
3.	Design and label a celt costume, including a shield. (You could model your design on an old Barbie or figurine).	3
4.	Create a comic strip for a day in the life of an Iron Age man/woman.	2
5.	Write a review of our visit from Iron Age Mat.	2
6.	Grow a plant of your choice and bring it in on the last week of term. Take weekly photographs (or drawings) to monitor how it grows.	3
7.	Create a table showing the similarities and differences between the Iron Age and modern day.	2
8.	Measure the perimeter of a room in your house in m and cm.	2
9.	Make a list of the necessities that a plant needs to survive.	1
10.	Make an Iron Age settlement (to include a hillfort and Iron Age house). You could use papier mache or card, or any other materials you have around the house.	6
11.	Draw and label the parts of a plant.	2
12.	Make a Christmas decoration for the class.	3
